



For Brachycephalic breed animals (Snub Nose)

Flights:

Virgin class x breeds as a Brachy Breed whereas Qantas will fly x breeds as per non Brachy Breed Animals.

There are extra costs to be aware of

AIRLINES STIPULATE THAT WE MUST have an agent at both Departure and Arrival Points for lodging and hand over on day of flight.

Cost will vary depending on area and date/time of lodging/collection. Agents will have a surcharge for outside business hours.

You MUST have a BOAS check completed with vet. (VIRGIN STIPULATE THAT YOUR VET MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE AUSTRALIAN VETINRARY ASSOCIATION)

You MUST choose a crat size one up from that of which a similar sized dog or cat would normally need (see notes on choosing correct crate size)

There are other conditions for Brachy Breeds such as time of day and weather conditions to think about.

Qantas will fly all hours depending on the weather but Virgin WILL NOT fly between the hours of 9am and 6pm. (As of June 2024, Virgin will fly all hours, depending on weather conditions June through to August.

Virgin do not fly Brachy Breeds out of certain ports. You can contact us to discuss.

Up to low 20 degree is ok for breeds. But you do not want to fly them if quite humid.

They are not to be flown during thunder storms or extreme weather.

If you are unsure, please call or email to discuss.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK WEATHER CONDITIONS RIGHT UP TO FLIGHT DAY/TIME.

If the weather in not suitable, you must call immediately to change your flight date or time.
